To obtain a Certificate in Economics, students must complete 12 hours in economics as outlined below:

ECON 201 Principles of Microeconomics ECON 202 Principles of Macroeconomics

Plus any two of the following classes:

Either ECON 301 Intermediate Microeconomics (PR: ECON 201 & 202) or ECON 651 Managerial Economics (PR: ECON 201)

ECON 302 Intermediate Macroeconomics (PR: ECON 201 & ECON 202)

ECON 640 Money and Banking (PR: ECON 202)

Either ECON 644 International Economics or FIN 645 Int'l Finance (PR: ECON 201 & ECON 202)

(No grade lower than a "C" is acceptable for the classes taken in this certificate program.)

To obtain your official certificate for the economics certificate program, please fill out this "Intent to Complete a Certificate in Economics" form and return it to the Department of Economics, Finance, and Accounting in MC 201 or send electronically to efa@fhsu.edu during the semester you are completing your final class for the certificate.
