

Banking Certificate (12 hours)

The Banking Certificate provides academic preparation for students who want to have a career in banking. To obtain a Banking Certificate, students must complete 12 hours as outlined below:

ACCT 203 Principles of Accounting I

FIN 201 Principles of Banking (PR: ACCT 203)

(The course number for FIN 201 will change to FIN 301 starting Spring 2026.)

FIN 642 Bank Management (PR: FIN 201)

FIN 643 Bank Strategy (Capstone class – should be taken last)

(No grade lower than a “C” is acceptable for the classes taken in this certificate program.)

All classes for the Banking Certificate are available online.

To obtain your official certificate for the banking certificate program, please fill out this “Intent to Complete the Banking Certificate” form and return it to the Department of Economics, Finance, and Accounting in MC 201 or send electronically to efa@fhsu.edu during the semester you are completing your final class for the certificate. You should receive your certificate in the mail approximately 6-8 weeks after you complete all requirements.
